If you have reason to believe your child may have a disability and need special education and/or related services, you may refer your child for an evaluation of eligibility. Reasons to suspect an educational disability may include one of the following:

- a. Delay in physical, social/emotional, communication, or cognitive development
- b. Medical conditions that affect learning, such as neurological and genetic disorders,
- c. Unsatisfactory performance on group achievement tests or accountability measures
- d. Multiple academic and behavioral warnings
- e. Lack of improvement or response to intervention
- f. Repeated failure in one or more subjects
- g. Failure to pass a vision or hearing screening

To refer your child to special education contact your neighborhood school and ask to speak to the special education department.
